**High Water Use Plants (more than 1" a week)**

<u>Common Name</u>	<u>Botanical Name</u>
Snowdrift	<i>Astilbe x arendsii</i>
Red Sentinel	<i>Astilbe x japonica</i>
Bebb's Sedge	<i>Carex bebbii</i>
Smallwing Sedge	<i>Carex microptera</i>
European Lily of the Valley	<i>Convallaria majalis</i>
Pinky-Winky Hydrangea	<i>Hydrangea paniculata</i>
Rocky Mountain Iris	<i>Iris missouriensis</i>
Baltic Rush	<i>Juncus balticus</i>
Sword Leaf Sedge	<i>Lepidosperma gladiatum</i>
Mimulus	<i>Mimulus cardinalis</i>
